**Deadline for submission of papers:** May 3, 2022. Manuscripts submitted prior to this date will be eligible for consideration for publication in the Special Issue.

All manuscripts must be submitted through the Journal's website: <http://joe.msubmit.net> -

Authors should include a cover letter when submitting their manuscript indicating that the contribution is intended for the "**UComms21 Special Issue**", and a pdf of their UComms 21 paper. If the authorship deviates from the short paper presented at UComms21 and published in IEEE Xplore, the changes should be described and explained.

The Guest Editors strongly encourage authors to consider supporting JOE efforts to publish reproducible results through sharing of code and data. This way, other researchers can build upon your work and your contributions will have higher impact in our community, increasing the value of your paper and potentially increasing citation rate.
